The board approved a \$0.30 lunch increase and \$0.10 breakfast increase for the student meal prices for the 2022-2023 school year. Breakfast for students K-5 will be \$1.55 and students 6-12 will be \$1.60. Lunch for students K-5 will be \$3.25 and students 6-12 will be \$3.30.
