Call to Order at 6:00 pm by Chairman Gary Roth

<u>Roll Call</u>: Commissioners Gary Roth, Carl Kinsky, Justin Donovan, Amanda Hutchings, and Kathy Waltz (by phone) were present. Administrator David Bova was also present. Commissioners Tony Grass and Gina Bryant, and Alderman Joe Prince were absent.

<u>Approval of the Agenda</u>: Commissioner Donovan made a Motion to Approve the agenda as presented; Commissioner Kinsky seconded the motion, which passed 5-0-3.

<u>Approval of the Minutes</u>: Commissioner Donovan made a Motion to Approve the minutes of the May 5, 2022 meeting as presented; Commissioner Hutchings seconded the motion, which passed 5-0-3.

Introduction of Evidence: Mr. Bova presented the Ste. Genevieve Municipal Code, the Ste. Genevieve Comprehensive Plan, and the Staff Report and supporting documents for the requests. Commissioner Kinsky made a Motion to Recommend Approval of the Special Use Permit to the Board of Aldermen which was seconded by Commissioner Waltz and passed 5-0-3.
