

Ste. Genevieve County Commission Minutes

MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 12, 2022

29TH Day of the July Term. The Commission Met Pursuant to Adjournment. Present were Presiding Commissioner Garry Nelson, Associate Commissioners Karen Stuppy and Randy Ruzicka. Deputy County Clerk, Michele Gatzemeyer was absent from today's meeting.

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY PRESIDING COMMISSIONER NELSON AT 8:00 A.M.

THE MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING THAT WAS HELD ON THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 8, 2022 ARE SCHEDULED TO BE READ AT THE NEXT REGULARLY SCHEDULED COMMISSION MEETING TO BE HELD ON THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 15, 2022.

Conference call held with Spectrum/MasTec surrounding the on-going issues as they pertain to cable installation and the 'many' on-going issues that have resulted accordingly. Following were details reported from said 'Call':

*Decision was made to meet 'on-site' @ Ditch Road 'location' on Tuesday, 9/20/22 @ 8:00 A.M. Details will follow accordingly.

*Jackson School Road – R&B Department still having difficulty w/mowing. Boxes moved; poles were suggested to be placed around said 'Boxes'. The 'County' was advised by Spectrum that this cannot be done.

*Jones Road – Clean up Crew addressing issue tomorrow.

*Watts Road – This is 'project' still being worked on.

*River Aux Vases Church Road – Culvert Pipe to be replaced @ 14105 River Aux Vases Church Road. Boring Machine used by MasTec went through the same; Spectrum Contractor to replace it.

*14604 River Aux Vases Church Road – Work still being completed.

*15925 River Aux Vases Church Road – Work Completed; however, construction still being done in area.

*15926 River Aux Vases Church Road – "Trash" removed; area cleaned up.

*17808 River Aux Vases Church Road – Work completed; work is finished.

*18460 River Aux Vases Church Road – Work is completed.

*18530 River Aux Vases Church Road – Work is completed.

*13105 Watts Road – Yard restored. Property owner satisfied. Work complete.

*13325 Watts Road – Work completed.

*15535 Highway B – Pedestal reported to have been installed on 'private property'. Issue needs to be addressed.

*13211 Schwartz Road – Landowner claims hydraulic oil all over road; pictures were taken. Trucks pulled in resident's yard. Follow up to be completed on said property location.

*ENTRANCE TO STE. GENEVIEVE COUNTY 'ROAD & BRIDGE' SHED – Asphalt was tore up in front of the same. Repairs are to be made accordingly.

*Residents have complained surrounding the 'Rocks' @ back of Copper Mine Road. Local residents mow the same; issues with the rocks, which do NOT ALLOW for mowing.

*Highway Y – MasTec Crews to be in area next week and have identified necessary repairs to be made.

Mr. Scott Schmieder, R&B Foreman, appeared before the Commission to provide report on the following issues for today's meeting:

*Chestnut Ridge 'Subdivision' – List of 'issues' to be provided to residents requesting that 'roads' within 'subdivision' be taken over by the 'County'. Road specifications are not close to being met. Issues being identified for distribution to those residents with questions surrounding said matter.

*Mr. Schmieder – Boards needed for trailers.

*Chip & Sealing being completed on Saddleback Trail.

*Mr. Schmieder reported work on Dry Fork Road complete (Road to be swept off when weather allows); work being done on Turley Mill School Road & Buchholz Road.

Commission discussed 'Invoice' from IDC (Industrial Development Corporation). Said invoice being 'held' as 'Commission' does not have representative on said 'Board'. This is matter to be discussed more in depth.

*Mr. Shrum noted that Ambulance District rebuilding 'House #3' on same property.

Local property owner on Flieg Drive noted that Contractor for Spectrum caused damage on private road.

Accounts Payable for Date 9/12/2022 in the amount of \$51,369.52 were reviewed and approved for payment by the Commission.
