Issue:

The Ste. Genevieve County 911 Tax Board requested the City continue to budget for dispatching services to assist the board in raising enough capital to fund the system improvements, pay for normal dispatching services, and help build a reserve fund for future expenses.

Re: Jefferson St. No Parking



Issue:

This request was brought forward to Alderman Bennett to restrict parking during school hours along portions of Jefferson Street on the south side due to visibility issues when exiting the lower parking lot onto Jefferson from the lot used by Valle students.

The board was uncertain how much of the area needed to be no parking until having a chance to look at it. The school also advised the City that they will be adding a playground area in the upper parking lot that will eliminate parking spaces there.

Recommendation:

Discuss and review whether to create no parking along a stretch of Jefferson on the south side and the amount of area to restrict for an ordinance to be brought to the board.
