Grants

2022 DPS Grant application

I have applied for a \$43,000 no match grant for radio replacement I received notification that the grant request for \$43,000 for radio equipment was fully funded. The State has given permission to order the radios. Radios have been ordered.

2023 DPS Grant

Received notification that the grant program will open soon. I intend to apply again to try to get some of our handheld radios upgraded. This will be a no matching funds grant, the same as the last 2 DPS grants. Grant has been submitted for approximately \$72,000. Grant has been approved. Waiting for permission from the state to order.

ARP Grant

There is a maximum of \$20,000 and our match will be 50% of the amount requested. I am asking permission to proceed with the grant request with the amount not to exceed \$20,000 with a required match not to exceed \$10,000. The required match funding will be available from our rural fire fund. The turnout gear came in \$1,384.78 under budget. I have made an award adjustment request to the grant program to use that money to increase the number of helmets that we can purchase s long as we don't exceed the total amount of our awarded grant. Received permission to increase the number of helmets to order. Request before the board to purchase 28 helmets for this grant. This is a 50% match and the money is available in the rural fire fund.

MINUTES OF THE STE. GENEVIEVE BOARD OF ALDERMEN WORK SESSION THURSDAY - July 27, 2023

The work session of the Ste. Genevieve Board of Aldermen was called to order by Mayor Brian Keim at 6:24 p.m. with the following members present:

A motion was made by Alderman Steiger second by Alderman Cleghorn to approve the work session agenda. Motion carried 7-0-1 with Alderman Smith absent.

BUSINESS ITEMS:

FIRE TAGS. Ken Steiger - Fire Chief went over some price increases to the City's rural fire tags. He feels like we should follow the prices that Bloomsdale Fire Department has set up. After some discussion it was noted that City Administrator Welch will bring an ordinance with the increases to the board at the next meeting.

JEFFERSON STREET - NO PARKING AREA. The board discussed no parking on certain sections of Jefferson Street. It was decided to add one additional no parking space to the recommended area.

TEXTING COSTS. The board discussed if we should put money in the budget for a texting notification system. TextCaster ran the city \$4,000 a year in 2020. We did have four sponsors. The quote from Code Red is \$4,600 and if we do a five-year commitment the cost would be less. We will also look at getting sponsors again. Happy will get more information and see if this is a user-friendly system and we will add it in with the budget for 2024.

CBIZ SALARY CONCLUSIONS - RECOMMENDATIONS. Happy stated that CBIZ gave us some recommendations and a summary of findings. The cost to implement the new staff structure is approximately \$11,809 and the police cost \$4,041. This would bring all employees to the minimum of their proposed ranges or to their step rate. The initial cost to implement the new step structures is approximately \$38,950. This brings all employees to their new step rate. The cost to implement the compression adjustments would be approximately \$18,121. After discussion with the board, it was decided to make two separate budgets for them to review. One budget that includes the recommendations by CBIZ and a 3% cost of living adjustment. The other budget would only include a 3% cost of living adjustment.

TRASH HAULER - SINGLE SUPPLIER IN CITY. Happy stated that if the board wants to go with looking at a single supplier we must go out for RFP's and allow a 2-year window before the chosen contractor could start. There was a lot of discussion on this and how it would affect city residents by us choosing their provider. The survey that was done most people responded that they did not think the City should choose the provider for them. It was also mentioned that the city just needed to limit the size of trucks. This will be brought back to the board for further discussion.

Historic Painting Workshop Agreement

This Agreement is entered into by and between the City of Ste. Genevieve, a municipal corporation (the "City"), and French Colonial America _______, the owner of certain real estate located within the City of Ste. Genevieve (the "Property Owner"), and property commonly known as 167 South Gabouri St. _______, Ste. Genevieve, Missouri 63670 (the "Property").

WHEREAS the City of Ste. Genevieve and the Ste. Genevieve Heritage Commission, through a grant from the Historic Preservation Fund, have secured funding for a two (2) day painting workshop to be held on September 30, 2023 and October 1, 2023; and

WHEREAS the painting workshop will be performed on a "landmark" or "contributing" residential property located within the Ste. Genevieve National Historic District; and

WHEREAS the house must be a historically framed property with clapboard siding that has failing paint; and

WHEREAS the siding on the house must be accessible from the ground due to no workshop participants being allowed to work on ladders; and

WHEREAS Property Owner has applied to the City of Ste. Genevieve to have the Property be the subject of the two (2) day painting workshop; and

WHEREAS the City of Ste. Genevieve has designated the Property Owner's Property to be used as the subject property for the two (2) day painting workshop.

NOW THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby mutually acknowledged, the City and Property Owner hereby agree as follows:

- 1. **Property:** Property Owner has applied for the privilege of being selected as the property for a two (2) day painting workshop to be held on September 30, 2023 and October 1, 2023. Property Owner represents to City that the Property is a landmark or contributing residential property located within the Ste. Genevieve National Register Historic District. Further, Property Owner represents that the Property is a historic framed property with clapboard siding that has failing paint and is accessible from the ground for the two (2) day painting workshop.
- 2. <u>Painting Workshop:</u> Property Owner agrees to the following with regard to the painting workshop:
 - a. Property Owner and City agree that the two (2) day painting workshop shall be held on September 30, 2023 and October 1, 2023 unless the parties agree in writing to have the painting workshop conducted on a different date;
 - b. Property Owner is consenting to City personnel, workshop participants, workshop instructors and media to be present on the Property during the painting workshop

- hours. The parties anticipate that there will be twelve (12) to twenty (20) individuals present on the Property during the painting workshop;
- c. Property Owner agrees to supply adequate access to electricity for tools and vacuums during the painting workshop; and
- d. The paint color, brand, type and quantity of the paint used during the painting workshop will be mutually agreed upon by Property Owner, City and the painting workshop contractor which will conform with the design guidelines for the Ste. Genevieve National Register Historic District.
- 3. <u>City's Obligations:</u> The City will pay up to One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for the final top coat paint used on Property during and after the painting workshop. The City shall coordinate the scheduling of the painting workshop, including selecting all of the participants and attendees of the painting workshop.
- 4. Property Owner's Obligations After Painting Workshop: Property Owner agrees to complete the painting of the exterior of the Property after the workshop by the 31st day of December , 2023. Property Owner acknowledges that the painting workshop participants will only be painting a small portion of the exterior of the structure. Property Owner agrees that all work and treatments, including paint removal methods, patching, priming and other work performed on the Property, will conform to the Secretary of Interior standards for the treatment of historic properties.
- 5. <u>Liability & Indemnification:</u> Property Owner shall be solely responsible for all liability related to the Property. To the fullest extent permitted by law, Property Owner shall indemnify, hold harmless and defend City, and its employees and agents, from and against all claims, damages, losses and expenses, including, but not limited to, attorney fees, resulting from any negligent act, misconduct or omission in the part of Property Owner, its employees, agents, assigns or contractors, with regard to the maintenance of the Property.
- 6. **Payment:** Other than the City's obligation to pay no more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) of the final top coat paint, neither party shall pay the other party any money or consideration pursuant to this agreement.
