September 28, 2023

- 1. We have 3 to 4 more interviews this week for the tourism marketing director position. I hope to have someone hired the first week of October and they can start in 30 days or so.
- 2. I will be out of the office October 5 & 6. That means no work session agenda for October 12.
- 3. Demolition is complete at city hall with ceiling insulation installed and wall construction starting this week. We've worked out some on-the-fly adjustments but have not encountered any major issues with the demo.
- 4. The city hall committee met to review the single bid reply we had for the boardroom audio/video installation. The committee limited the expenditure to \$50,000. The bid came back at \$62,479 and the committee made some recommendations for reducing the costs to get it below \$50,000. The vendor replied that the finished product would not work satisfactorily and doesn't want to install a partial system.
- 5. We met with Cochran Engineering Monday morning (9/25) to discuss some issues with the 9^{th} St. engineering plans they are drafting. We're still in the preliminary phase on that at this point.

Collection/Distribution

Collections

- Staff jetted just over 3980ft of lines this month.
- Heavy rains caused minimal issues to the system during the rain event
- Ordered all manhole risers for the street overlay projects, that are coming up.
- All station were mowed, weedeated and sprayed.
- Met with Equipment Pro about issues with Virginia St Lift Station. These needed parts will not be available until late September.
- All lift stations were inspected at a minimum of 3 times per week. Staff inspects for grease build up, vandalism, and any electrical issues that would indicate issues with pumps, motors, or controls.

- Staff flushed hydrants through the night ensuring everyone had water as normal.
- Staff was tasked with street washdowns after the creeks overflowed and left mud on roads.
- All remote buildings were cleaned, inspected.

MINUTES OF THE STE. GENEVIEVE BOARD OF ALDERMEN WORK SESSION

THURSDAY - September 14, 2023

The work session of the Ste. Genevieve Board of Aldermen was called to order by Alderman Bob Donovan at 6:35 p.m. with the following members present:

Alderman Patrick Fahey

A motion was made by Alderman Prince, second by Alderman Eydmann to approve the work session agenda. Motion carried 6-0-2 with Alderwoman Cleghorn and Alderman Bennett absent.

BUSINESS ITEMS:

STORMWATER BEHIND 744 ROZIER (HIGHWAY M). City Administrator Happy Welch reported to the board that he does not have a cost estimate for cleaning out the stormwater swale that runs behind Duke Bleckler's house at 744 Rozier Street. Attorney Mark Bishop gave his opinion in a letter stating that the City currently does not have a legal right or authority to enter upon the land to clear out the swale. If the City would want to take on this responsibility, he recommends that the City obtain easements from all the property owners affected by the work before starting the project. Attorney Bishop also recommends a survey of the area.

Attorney Bishop stated that the City will have to decide whether this issue is appropriate for City action as opposed to leaving it to the various property owners to address. Alderman Prince stated that this would set a precedence and feels that we should not clean this out. Alderman Steiger stated that stormwater is going to become a bigger issue and the board needs to address it.

IMPROVEMENTS TO FERRY LANDING - ROTARY PROJECT. Alderman Steiger reported that the rotary is coming up on a 50-year milestone and would like to do put together a public improvement project that would benefit the City. When people come across the ferry to our side of the Mississippi it is an eye sore. The Rotary would like to see this paved and have some benches, trashcans and maybe some trees planted to improve the look. Rotary is willing to put up to \$25,000 towards this project. The Port Authority would donate money for the permits needed. He would like to get this annexed into the City so the City can get the easements needed and oversee the project. Then the City would be able to maintain this area after it's completed.

Larry Jones with Stream Team reported that they put trash cans at the Ferry Landing and the Marina during the 4th of July. This helped reduce some of the littering in these areas. Ron Inman commented that he feels the Railroad and Mississippi Lime would work with us to make this look more welcoming. Mickey Koetting stated that she would like to see boats dock here and bring people in to shop and eat.

The Board is in favor of seeing improvements here. This will be looked into by City Administrator Welch later on.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF STE. GENEVIEVE, MISSOURI STATING INTENT TO APPLY FOR A MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES GRANT FOR FY2024 TO DEVELOP A WALKING TOUR APP FOR HISTORIC STE. GENEVIEVE.

WHEREAS, The City of Ste. Genevieve Community Development Administrator has identified a need to apply for a grant from the Missouri Department of Natural Resources to develop and launch a walking tour app of historic Ste. Genevieve; and

WHEREAS, the City would hire an SaaS company with a place-based, mobile walking tour service and utilize the Secretary of Interior's Professional Qualification Guidelines to develop and write the content; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to apply for a Grant and, if awarded and allocated, the Cities portion (60%) would be funded from the FY 2025 Budget; General Revenue Fund in the Community Development Department under Grant Expenses line item 10-14-8216.

SECTION ONE: The City Staff and officials of the City of Ste. Genevieve are hereby authorized to prepare and submit an application for a FY24 Historic Preservation Grant Fund (attached as Exhibit "A") to fund approximately 60% of the total grant or \$18,000.00.

SECTION TWO: This resolution is in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
