Curriculum Report

- For the past couple weeks have been working on Fall Benchmark testing in reading and math for grades K
 12th
- Social Emotional Learning lessons are being taught on Mondays. Pre-K-8th grade is using a program called Second Step and 9th-12th grad is using a program called Character Strong
- Jr. High students and 2nd-5th grade are using a program called Freckle. This program is integrated with Star reading and math testing results therefore it is personalized for each student
- High school students are using a personalized learning program called IXL, reading is on Tuesdays and math on Thursdays.
- On October 25, 2023 the high school junior will be taking the Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test, the assessment will be in digital format
