**Issue:**

Transportation Alternative Program grants (TAP) from MoDOT will be opening early next year and if the board is interested we need to select or prioritize TAP projects and request Cochran to give us cost estimates on your choices. All TAP grants applied for this year have been approved.

If we would be approved next year major construction doesn't begin, most likely, until 2028.

**Recommendation:**

Determine the board's interest in another TAP grant like St. Mary's Road.

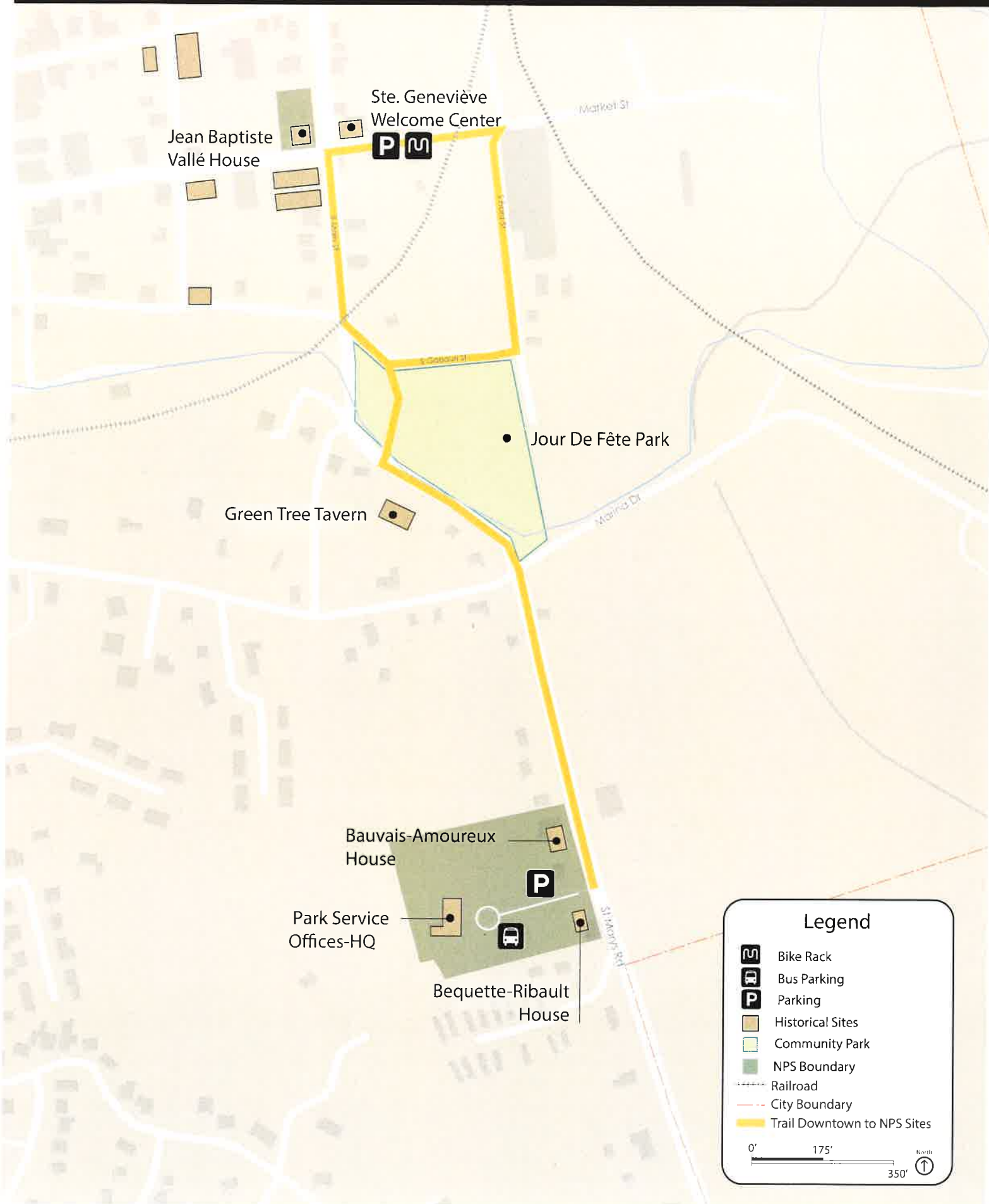
- 1) Sidewalk additions / improvements on 9<sup>th</sup> St, 8<sup>th</sup> St, LeCompte, & Washington for kids walking to school
- 2) Sidewalk additions / improvements on Highway 32 connecting the commercial district to Progress Parkway
- 3) Bicycle trail (and sidewalk) from ferry landing to city park
- 4) Traffic-calming (more like traffic islands) to prevent wrong-way driving on Merchant & Market
- 5) Sidewalk extension from Gerard St. to Rozier on east side of Highway 32 (S. 4<sup>th</sup> St.)
- 6) Sidewalk from Seraphin to Green Tree Tavern and consider new bridge structure

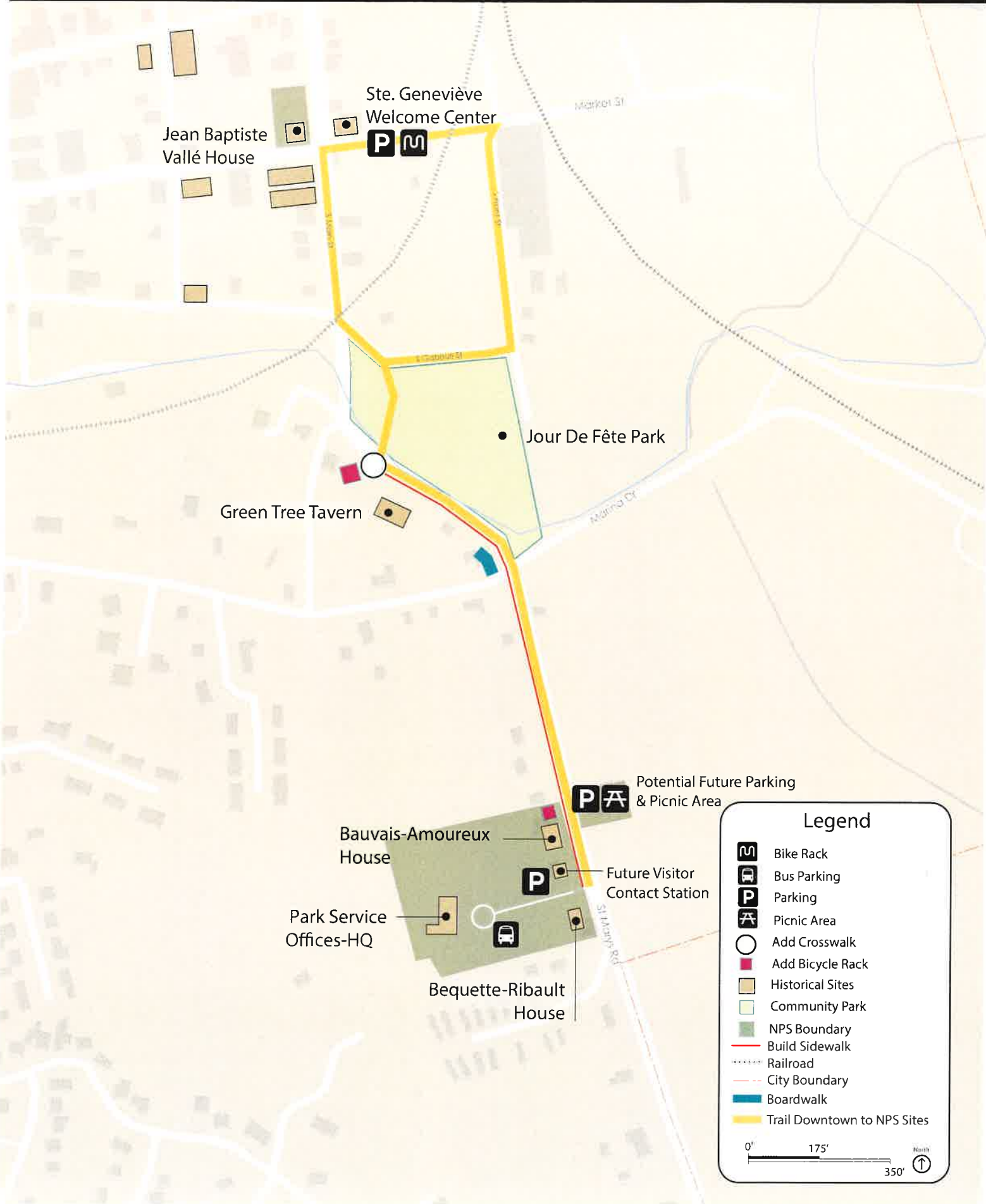
