
If we would be approved next year major construction doesn't begin, most likely, until 2028.


Recommendation:

Determine the board's interest in another TAP grant like St. Mary's Road.

- 1) Sidewalk additions / improvements on 9th St, 8th St, LeCompte, & Washington for kids walking to school
- 2) Sidewalk additions / improvements on Highway 32 connecting the commercial district to Progress Parkway
- 3) Bicycle trail (and sidewalk) from ferry landing to city park
- 4) Traffic-calming (more like traffic islands) to prevent wrong-way driving on Merchant & Market
- 5) Sidewalk extension from Gerard St. to Rozier on east side of Highway 32 (S. 4th St.)
- 6) Sidewalk from Seraphin to Green Tree Tavern and consider new bridge structure
