Perry County School District 32 Inclement Weather Notifications

District administrators and bus drivers monitor weather forecasts before and during a winter precipitation event, then drive roads in the city and county to determine if it is safe to send school buses out. They also consider the safety of sidewalks and parking lots on campus.

If the decision is made to cancel school, the automated messaging system is used to send a text, email, and voice call to all parents. We use all three contact methods for cancellations and early dismissals to reduce the likelihood that any student is left at home or at a bus stop without supervision. The calls will be made no later than 10 pm and no earlier than 5 am.

The district also posts school closings on its Facebook page and notifies the following media outlets:

In the event of a closure due to inclement weather, the district cancels all extracurricular activities on the first day; the situation will be reviewed for subsequent “snow days.”

Perry County School District No. 32 Emergency Bus Routes

The emergency plan was officially adopted by the Board of Education of Perry County School District No. 32 in a board session on October 11, 2023. The plan will put a school bus within five miles of most of our patrons. We must rely on parents to get their children to school or to and from the emergency bus routes. If the bus connection is some distance from a child's home, we must rely on parents to plan with neighbors and friends for a place where the child can wait for the bus in the morning and get off in the afternoon.

Even this plan cannot work immediately after a major storm. (snow, flooding, etc) If the emergency bus routes are to be used, this would be announced over our normal news release channels which are: KFVS TV Channel 12 (Cape Girardeau), KSGM Radio 980 FM (Perryville/Ste. Genevieve), KREI Radio AM 800 (Farmington), KTJJ Radio FM 98.5, KZIM Radio FM 100.7 (Cape Girardeau); K103 Radio FM 102.9 (Cape Girardeau), The Republic-Monitor (www.perryvillenews.com); automated telephone service, and the District 32 mobile app; and social media platforms.

The District Transportation office will gather information as indicated (as early as possible) and report the conditions of the road to the Superintendent and Assistant Superintendent. The District Administration will then make a decision. This decision will be made as early as possible. Notification of no school will be made through the above system(s) to students and parents.

5	Bus will start picking up at 7:00 am, Hwy NN & PCR 840, proceed east on Hwy NN to Hwy 61. (PCR 844, 819, 840 will meet at 840 & Hwy NN) Students on Hwy 61 will be picked up at their regular stops. Right on Hwy M. (PCR 814 will meet at Hwy M) (PCR 816 and 806 will meet at the intersection of 806 & 816) Bus will turn around at 806 & 816 and proceed to school.
6	Bus will turn around at Hwy 61 & Millcreek Ln. Bus will start picking up at 6:40 am on Hwy 61, proceed north on Hwy 61 picking up regular stops. (PCR 530, 402, 406, 404 will meet at Hwy 61) Bus will proceed east on Hwy D with regular pick ups. (Hwy U and PCR 330 will meet at Hwy D) Bus will proceed north on Hwy C with regular pick ups. (PCR 328 will meet at Hwy C) Bus will back into PCR 351 to turn around. Left on Hwy C right on Hwy P. Regular pick ups on Hwy P (PCR 318 will meet at Hwy P)
7	Bus will start picking up at 6:20 am at Hwy CC & PCR 718, proceed north on Hwy CC with regular pick ups. Right on Hwy T to the intersection of Hwy T & Hwy 51. Right on Hwy 51 to Becky's Garage @ 6:50. (10958 & 10561 S Hwy 51 and Hwy KK will meet here) Bus will proceed north on Hwy 51, Left on Hwy J with regular pick ups & turn around. (Pcr 724 will meet at Hwy J) Return to Hwy 51 proceed north on Hwy 51 with regular stops.

10	Regular stops in town.
11	Bus will start picking up @ PCR 321 and hwy E @ 6:50, proceeds hwy E to Hwy 61. Regular stops in town

13	Bus will start picking up at 6:45 am Hwy H & Moll Residence, will proceed west on Hwy H to Hwy 61, then left on Hwy 61. Regular stops on Hwy 61. (PCR 830 & 832 will meet @ Hwy 61)
14	Bus will start picking up at St. Maurus Church @ 6:40. (Hwy O, PCR 630 & Hwy K will meet at the church) Hwy B will have regular pick ups. Bus will proceed to Hwy F with regular stops on Hwy F. (PCR 520 will meet at Hwy F) Bus will make a left on Hwy 61 south and continue regular pick ups. Bus will make a left on Hwy AA and turn around at PCR 508. (PCR 510, 512, 514 & 508 will meet at the intersection of 508 & Hwy AA) Proceed south on Hwy 61 with regular pick ups.
15	Bus will start picking up at 6:45 am @ Hwy M & Hwy 61 proceed north on Hwy M to Hwy H. (PCR 932, 930, 926, 928, 922 will meet @ Hwy M) Bus will make a right on Hwy H, then a right on Hwy 51 with regular pick ups. (PCR 917 meet @ Hwy 51) regular stops in town
16	Bus will start picking up at 6:30 am @ Hwy BB & PCR 738. (PCR 738 will meet at Hwy BB) Proceed north on Hwy BB to Hwy T. Right on Hwy T with regular pick ups through the corner of Progress Dr & Grand (PCR 730, 717, 726, 856, & 858 will meet at Hwy T) (PCR 700 & 701 will meet at the Eagles parking lot)
17	Bus will start picking up at 7:10 am @ N. Main & Hwy 51, proceed south on N. Main. Right on N Hwy 61 regular pick ups. Left on Moulton, Left on Old St. Mary's Rd. Left on Bruce St. left on Harry St, Right on Lucy St Right on Hwy 61 (PCR 210, 206, 200 meet @ 200 & Main St.)
18	Same as regular route.
19	Bus will start picking up at 7:00 am @ Hwy V & PCR 914, proceed south on Hwy V to the intersection of Hwy V & Hwy 61. Regular stops in town. (PCR 916 & 914 will meet @ Hwy V)
