BOARD NEWS

A Summary of the Board of Education Meeting: December 13, 2023

Open Session:

- The board approved the consent agenda items which consisted of:
 - 1) The November 08, 2023 Workshop minutes.
 - 2) The November 08, 2023 Regular Session minutes.
 - 3) MSBA policies: BBBA-1, BBF and IGC.
 - 4) The November warrants.

New Business:

- The board approved the motion to go into closed session after the open session to discuss student and personnel matter as permitted by RSMo. 160.021 Sections (3), (6), (13) & (14).
- RSMo. 106.077 "Get the Lead Out of School Drinking Water Act:

On or before January 1, 2024, each school shall complete requirements outlined in the act including: conducting an inventory of all drinking water outlets and outlets used for dispensing water for cooking or cleaning utensils in each school building, develop a plan for testing each outlet and make such plan available to the public and providing general information on the health effects of lead contamination to employees and parents of children at each school.

Before August 1, 2024, or the first day on which students will be present in the building, whichever is later, schools shall conduct testing for lead as stated in the act. Within 2 weeks after receiving test results, schools shall make all testing results and any remediation plans available on the school's website.

The board approved St. John Environmental Consulting, LLC to complete all necessary water sampling and testing as outlined in their proposed bid.

• FY 2024-2025 school calendar:

Dr. Jones proposed a FY 2024-2025 school calendar. The calendar committee reflected on community survey results and staff input during the creation of the proposed calendar. A few changes to the calendar were that AMI was removed and 10 built in snow days were included. Students will not make up snow days. The board approved the FY 2024-2025 school calendar, as presented.

• First State Community Bank:

Dennis Bohnert, Perryville's branch president, gave a summary of FSCB's new structure of using ICS as a way of securing large deposits.

• Survey Climate and Culture update:

We encourage everyone to fill in the climate and culture survey. It will be open until Dec. 18th. Survey results are factors in driving decision making. The results will be presented in the Jan. 10th board meeting.

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• CSIP revision upcoming:

The CSIP committee will review the CSIP and make necessary revisions. The Instructional section will be a focus point due to new resources available. Meetings will start up Jan. 2024.

• Teacher professional development day report:

Jane Narrow presented a list of P.D. activities, per building that occurred on Nov. 20th & 21st PD days.
