Improvements and Accomplishments

CURRICULUM:

- NWEA reports were analyzed in Grades K-5 to determine strengths, opportunities for improvement, and significant gaps. This information was used to individualize instruction for students.
- Student Learning Objectives were written to assess student growth throughout the school year. When applicable the NWEA test was administered as part of the SLO (beginning, middle, and end of year).
- Continued Preschool Program with great success. Mrs. Nichole Cyr, lead teacher, with Mrs. Jennifer Koetting as classroom teacher aide.
- Title I Supplemental ELA Teacher, Ms. Lynette Pfaff provided Tier 3 RTI instruction for students K-5, and collaborated with Mrs. Megan Kueker, Supplemental ELA Teacher at SGE to facilitate grade level consistencies with interventions and RtI processes.
- We continuously implement the Really Great Reading Phonics program at Grades K-3. Teachers analyzed the data to determine reteaching opportunities. Additional Really Great Reading data is analyzed during RTI meetings to determine Tier II instruction.
- Mrs. Jennifer Sutton, Title I Math Instructional Coach, assisted teachers with data analysis particularly NWEA data, use of best practices, and quality

lesson/assessment development.With the guidance and training Mrs. Sutton provided, all grade levels increased the use of math station teaching.

- Flex grouping was implemented at Grade 4 and 5th grade in the area of ELA to work with IDI groups.
- SeeSaw is the primary online platform for students to work virtually in the event of school closure or on AMI days.
- Teachers in Grades 2-5 used Google Classroom as the primary online platform for students to work virtually in the event of school closure or AMI days
- Weekly 50 minute collaborative team meetings were utilized by teachers at all grade levels to support collaborative team work on curriculum, instruction and assessment.
- Special Education Co-teaching implemented in grade 5.
- RtI (Response to Intervention) continued to be implemented at the kindergarten through fifth grade levels. The data was reviewed every four to six weeks and students were placed in appropriate intervention, on-level instruction, or enrichment groups. Grade level teachers, Special Education teachers, Mrs. Pfaff, Mrs. Grigaitis, and Mrs. Meyrose provided Tier I, II, and III instruction.
- Grades 4 and 5 implemented a 30 minute intervention block four days a week to focus on needed skills for students.
- Teachers in Grades K-3 completed Year 2 LETRS training along with Paige Naeger who was in second grade in the 2022-2023 school year. Second Grade teacher, Laura Gegg is in year 1 due to being in 4th grade in the 2022-2023 school year.
- Grades 4 5 (with the exception of Pagie Naeger) began Year 1 of LETRS training. Coach Basler and Laura Gegg also completed Year 1.
- CARE Teams are held every four to six weeks for all grade levels.
- Dragons' Den was provided as an after school program (\$150/quarterly cost to first student per family, \$100 for each second student in a family, and \$80 for student in a family thereafter) Starting enrollment 45, ending enrollment 53.
- Makayla Bader, Tyne Huck, Emma Springkamper, Cheryl Berkbigler, Laura Gegg, Amy Rowland, Stephanie Rayoum, and Kelly Heberlie visited Scott City Elementary to tour their special behavior program. The visits have been beneficial to bring back ideas for our future Tier II behavior program.
- Katie Gettinger, Rachel Kertz, Paige Naeger, Jennifer Kirchner, Kristi Byington, Laura Gegg, Stephanie Rayoum, Ashley Gettinger, Nichole Cyr, and Kelsey Beier, visited Pattonville or Chaffee to get some information about Competency Based Education and Standards Based grading.
