Staff

We hired a full-time paramedic and are now fully staffed for full-time. He has good experience and we are hoping it will be a good fit for both him and the District.

Training

The EMT Class was featured in an article in the newspaper. All six students in the class will test. There are two that for sure are interested in working here. There are good responses and the class looks promising for the future. Prerequisite guidelines are being considered for upcoming classes

In house monthly CEUs and CPR training for fire departments are completed. Beth is doing a good job keeping everyone up to date on their CEUs and certifications.

911

Our County 911 Board visited 911 Dispatching and had a concern on how calls are not being dedicated to our county. A letter was drafted to 911 and it was explained that it would cost us more to have a dedicated dispatcherTowers are up and progressing forward. Digital will be by the end of the year and there will be better communications. The fire departments can still be analog. There can be communications between analog and digital systems.

General Business

Feathershark has updated the network equipment and installed a new phone system. We are eliminating Big River and going with Spectrum for all our internet services.

We will look at moving the workers compensation insurance for the cheaper rate. Rates are based on previous claim history.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

House 3

The architect's office in Arnold was damaged in the tornado last Friday. He is out of the office this week and hopefully we will have something from him by next week. No grade estimations have been made. If we get something from him, we will schedule a work session meeting so we can shoot for doing bids in April.

NEW BUSINESS

We have a remount proposal. There are two trucks that will need to be done by 2028. The bid for remount is \$262,000 per truck. There could potentially be another \$20,000 savings per truck by cutting the HVAC system and changing the electrical system from MX to LXI. This is for

delivery of one truck in the fourth quarter of 2026 and another in the first quarter of 2027. This is locking in the pricing for the next two remounts.

\$370,000 is the cost for a new truck that is slated for delivery this December. This will put us with the fourth four-wheel drive truck. The two Fords will be able to remounted as well.

A motion was made to approve the two remounts for 2026 and 2027 with removal of HVAC and keeping the MX system.
