**BnB Dedicated Parking Space** 



The Martins improved the Defour house at 220 Merchant St. and are requesting dedicated parking in front of the house which is being used as a short-term rental for the renters. It would require signage not allowing other vehicles to park in front of the house. The house does not have its own off street parking spaces. Parking is allowed on Merchant, 2<sup>nd</sup> St., and the County parking lot off Market.

This street is used for restaurants, shops, the State Historic Site, a mead winery, and shows.

### Recommendation:

The City does parking permits for residents who will park for more than 2 hours but no dedicated parking spaces for residential. There is dedicated space in front of Common Grounds, 15 minute parking until 11a for customers. There are dedicated spaces for handicap parking.

Re: Fire Chief Volunteer Payment



### Issue:

When the board hired our part-time fire chief his salary was set during the budget process at \$18,000 for 24 hours/week.

Volunteer firefighters earn twice yearly callout/training pay and the chief has earned the same amount as the other fire officers of \$420.00 when paid in March and September. This amount was budgeted at the same time.

I need to know if the callout/training pay still applies and we will pay the chief asap. We have already cut checks for the other volunteers.

### **Recommendation:**

Please advise if the callout/training pay is in addition to the hourly part-time pay.
