Issue:

The board discussed needing stop signs at Maple and Virginia at the last work session. We were asked to talk to the school superintendent and police chief.

Independently of each other their recommendation is the same: Add stop signs to westbound Maple, southbound Virginia, and put in a No Left Turn sign for eastbound Maple but no stop sign.

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF STE. GENEVIEVE, MISSOURI, AMENDING SCHEDULE II TABLE II-A STOP SIGNS FOR THE INTERSECTION OF MAPLE AND VIRGINIA.

WHEREAS, the Ste. Genevieve School District Early Childhood Education Center ("ECEC") will be opening in August; and

WHEREAS, a new traffic pattern will be created with additional traffic on Maple to access the ECEC; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen believe it to be in the best interests of its residents to restrict the flow of traffic to better serve vehicle use.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF STE. GENEVIEVE, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Board of Aldermen hereby amends Municipal Code Schedule II Table II-A Stop Signs by adding stop signs at the intersection of Maple St. and Virginia St.:

Table II - A. Stop Signs:

Maple Street westbound

Street/Direction of Traffic

Virginia Street southbound

SECTION 2: The Board also directs the public works department to add a No Left Turn sign at the following:

NO LEFT TURN LOCATION: Maple Street eastbound

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall be codified into the Municipal Code.
